

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES: By participating, you agree that:

1. These Official Contest Rules may not be waived, modified, or supplemented except by the Southern Kentucky Performing Arts Centers (SKyPAC). No modification of these official contest rules shall be enforceable unless made by SKyPAC.
2. The raffle drawing shall be held at SKyPAC in Bowling Green, Kentucky. All tickets must be received by the drawing date and time to be eligible for the drawing.
3. Each ticket will be entered separately in the drawing. Each ticket is a separate and equal chance to win the specified prize(s).
4. Winners have 30 days to claim or take delivery of prizes, or forfeit all claims thereto.
5. Due to postal regulations, raffle ticket stubs cannot be returned by mail for purchases over the Internet, through the mail, or by telephone. When an order is placed, we will complete the ticket by filling in the name, address, and phone number, and we will drop the ticket in the barrel at SKyPAC. At the drawing, the winner will be contacted based on the name and information on the ticket. To pick up or receive prizes, winners will be required to present two forms of identification, one of which must be a photo ID to prove that this person is the person on the winning ticket. Purchasers do not need their ticket stubs for any reason. However, the stubs will be kept on file at SKyPAC. Purchasers can call SKyPAC to check when the order was processed and obtain their ticket number if so desired. Tickets can be picked up at SKyPAC during the hours of 10:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
6. If not present, winner notification will be made by telephone or mail.
7. Tickets are generally sold in numerical sequence. Various staff members taking orders may have batches of tickets, and in this case, tickets may be sold out of order. Requests for a specific ticket number are accommodated if possible, when ordered by phone or at the SKyPAC Ticket Office.
8. Participants must be at least 18 years old. Winners may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility at the discretion of SKyPAC.
9. Winner is solely responsible for all taxes, registration, title, transfer fees, license duties, insurance, and all expenses in claiming, registering and using the vehicle or other prizes. This may include sales taxes and property taxes. SKyPAC has no liability with regard to taxes and fees for the vehicle or other prizes.
10. Vehicle will not be modified by SKyPAC to meet specific local, state or country requirements.
11. All non-US residents will be required by IRS regulations to pay 30% US income tax on the value of the prize unless the winner is a resident of specific countries exempted by treaty. This amount will be withheld from the cash prize and submitted to the IRS on behalf of the winner. After the end of the year, SKyPAC will file a Form 1042 and 1042-S to report the value of the prize won and the taxes paid in by the winner. The winner will receive a copy of this also.

For raffles in which a trip is the prize, and the prize specifically includes airfare, SKyPAC will book the flight itinerary for a coach flight with times and number of stops at SKyPAC's discretion. For cruise prizes, the winner will receive a cruise on that specific ship on that specific date as advertised. Winner forfeits prize value if unable to go on that date.
13. Winner agrees to the use of his/her name, address, photograph or videotape likeness and statements for publicity purposes by SKyPAC, and agrees to sign a publicity release without any further compensation.

14. SKyPAC reserves the right to cancel this contest at any time, in which event its liability is limited to refund of ticket prices to participants. Model year and vehicle options advertised are based on availability.
15. SKyPAC employees, board members, and their immediate families are ineligible to win a prize in the raffle. Immediate family is defined to include spouse, children, and children's spouse.
16. Any person who engages in conduct designed to corrupt the outcome of a charitable gaming activity with the purpose to defraud, or knowing that he is facilitating a fraud, is guilty of a Class D felony.
